

## **GENERAL VIEW**

The general view and external features of ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> are shown below.



# **POWER SUPPLY**

ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> is powered by a special Li-ion polymer rechargeable battery.

✓ The battery is not user-replaceable.

### Power On / Power Off

- When the device is powered off, press and hold the *On/Off* button for 3 seconds to turn it on.
- $\checkmark$  It may take about 1 minute for the device to start up.
- When the device is powered on, press and hold the *On/Off* button for 3 seconds to turn it off.

## Standby Mode

- When the device is on, press and instantly release the *On/Off* button. The device will enter standby mode. The LCD will be switched off.
- When in standby mode, press and instantly release the *On/Off* button to resume operation.

## **Recharging the Battery**

ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> can operate continuously for over 24 hours. When the battery becomes weak, the battery life picture is shown as . To restore full functionality of the device, recharge the battery as soon as possible. We recommend that you recharge your jetBook<sup>®</sup> at night during at least four hours.

- Only a special charger may be used with your ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup>.
   Use of an inappropriate external power supply may cause failure of the device and will void the warranty.
- Unfasten the mini-USB port cover.
- Connect the AC/DC adapter to your device via the mini-USB port (see *General View*). The green LED signal shows that the battery is recharging. It normally takes 5 hours to recharge a depleted battery.

You can also recharge the battery using the supplied USB cable. However, it is recommended that you use the special charger.

### Initialization

In the rare event that the data on the screen is corrupted or a program is not responding properly, you will need to perform a reset. The *Reset* button is located on the back of the device. It can be accessed with any thin object like a paper clip. Never use a needle or a sharp pin for this purpose since it can damage the device.

• After pressing the *Reset* button, press and hold the *On/Off* button for 3 seconds to turn the device on.

# **INSTALLING SD CARD**

ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> supports SD cards of up to 2GB capacity for storing thousands of books.

- Unfasten the SD slot cover.
- If the card is not installed, slide it into the slot the contacts of the card face up, label face down. Push the card gently until it clicks into place.
- To eject the card, just push it in slightly.

## MAIN MENU

To display the *Main Menu*, turn the device on and/or press and hold the the text for 3 seconds. The *Main Menu* consists of the following sections: *Books, Music, Pictures,* and *Settings*.

# **READING BOOKS**

ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> comes with a set of preinstalled books. It also allows downloading additional books from various sources. The following book formats are supported: TXT (text files) and PDF.

## Selecting Language for Books in "TXT" (Text) Format

• Turn the device on.

- In the *Main Menu*, select *Settings* by pressing ▼ or ▲ and then press *OK*.
- Select User Settings, press OK and then select Languages.
- Select the language in which your book is written. Press OK.

## **Reading Books**

- In the *Main Menu*, Select *Books* by pressing ➤ or ▲ and then press *OK*. You will see a list of the available book titles.
- Use  $\checkmark$ ,  $\bigstar$  or  $\mathfrak{P}$  to scroll through the list.
- Press the corresponding numeric key on the right-hand side of the device to open the respective item. Alternatively, select it by pressing ➤ or ▲ and then press OK. If you have opened a wrong item, press ➤ to go back.

When in the reading mode, use:

- Implement to page up / page down;
- To switch screen orientation (portrait/landscape);
- to activate the Function menu which has the following options: Dictionary, Bookmark List, Bookmark This Page, Find, Jump To, Settings;
- Definition to change Font Size.

## Selecting Dictionary

The English⇔Russian, English⇔Polish, and English explanatory dictionaries built into ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> allow you to instantly translate an unfamiliar word.

- In the Main Menu, select Settings. You will see the Settings menu.
- Select User Settings and then select Dictionaries in the menu that appears. You will see the Dictionaries list.
- Select the desired dictionary and then press OK.

## Translating Unfamiliar Words

- When in the reading mode, press 🗐. You will see the *Function* menu.
- Select the *Dictionary* option. The menu will disappear.
- Press  $\checkmark$ ,  $\bigstar$ ,  $\checkmark$ ,  $\succ$  to highlight the word you want to translate.
- Press OK. You will see the *Explanation* window.
- Use ▼, ▲ to scroll through the dictionary entries.

## TRANSFERRING BOOKS, MP3 FILES, AND PICTURES

The USB mass storage capability allows you to copy electronic books, MP3 files and pictures to your device.

• Turn the device on. Turn your PC on.

• Unfasten the mini-USB port cover and then connect ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> to your computer using the supplied USB cable.

You will see the *Removable Disk* popup, and one removable disk icon (if no SD card is installed) or two removable disk icons (if an SD card is installed) will appear in the *My Computer* window.

- In the *My Computer* window, double-click the removable disk icon. When browsing through the contents stored in the internal memory of the device, you will see the following folders: *Books*, *Music*, and *Pictures*. **Do not delete or rename these folders!**
- Copy your files to the respective folders. For example, copy your books to the *Books* folder.
- $\checkmark$  There is no such a restriction for the files stored on the SD card.
- To disconnect ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> from your computer, click the Safely Remove Hardware icon at the bottom right of the screen and then select Safely remove USB Mass Storage Device in the menu that appears.
- In the *Main Menu*, open the desired section *Books, Music*, or *Pictures*. You will see the items you have copied and the preinstalled items, if any.

## **USING MP3 PLAYER**

- Copy your MP3 files to the *Music* folder as described above.
- Connect headphones to your ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup>.

- In the *Main Menu*, select *Music*. You will see the *MP3 Player* window.
- Select the desired file by pressing  $\checkmark$ ,  $\bigstar$  and then press *OK*.
- Use ≺, ≻ to adjust the volume. Use Page Up / Page Down to switch between adjacent items.
- To open the *Functions* menu, press A. You will see the following options: *Playlist*, *Turn off LCD*, *Play Modes*, *Background Music*, and *Hot keys*.

The *Turn off LCD* option allows you to save battery life.

• To turn the LCD back on, just press OK.

With the *Background Music* option selected, you can read books while listening to music – the *MP3 Player* window will be hidden; the program will be running in the background.

• To disable *Background Music*, open *MP3 Player* again, press **a**, and then select *Stop Backgr. Music* in the menu that appears.

## Playlist

- Press and then select *Playlist* in the *Functions* menu that appears.
- When the playlist is displayed, press the numeric key corresponding to the desired item to select or deselect it.
- Press and then select *Play Modes* in the *Functions* menu that appears. You will see the *Playback Mode* menu.

- Select Programmed (PROG).
- Finally, with the highlight on the selected item in the playlist, press *OK*.

# **VIEWING PICTURES**

ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> is capable of storing and displaying pictures in JPEG, GIF, PNG, and BMP formats.

- In the Main Menu, select Pictures. You will see the Pictures list.
- Select the desired file by pressing  $\checkmark$ ,  $\bigstar$  and then press *OK*. With a picture displayed, use:
  - □ to page up / page down;
  - To switch screen orientation (portrait/landscape);
  - Image: The second second
  - Æ to change zoom level.

# ENTERING LETTERS AND NUMBERS

When entering a text, please use the following information.

• Press the Page Up / Page Down keys to switch between English (ENG), Russian (RUS), Polish (POL), T9 English (T9 ENG), T9

Russian (*T9 RUS*), T9 Polish (*T9 POL*), and numeric (*123*) input modes.

## T9 Text Input

The T9 text input method uses built-in dictionaries that recognize the most commonly used words for each sequence of keystrokes.

- Enter the word by pressing one key per letter.
- The succession of letters displayed on the screen is not valid until the whole word is typed.
- Select the desired word and press OK.

# SETTINGS

Fine-tune your ECTACO<sup>®</sup> jetBook<sup>®</sup> by selecting options in the *Settings* section.

• In the *Main Menu*, select *Settings*. You will see the *Settings* menu which has the following submenus: *User Settings*, *System Settings*, *Internal File Manager*, *SD Card File Manager*, and *Background Music*. Their respective options are described below.

#### **User Settings**

Languages	Select the interface language: Russian, Polish, or
	English.

- *Auto Power* This feature saves battery life by putting the device Off into suspend mode after a specified period of inactivity: 3, 5, 10, 15, 30 minutes, or *Never*.
- Auto TurnWhen in the reading mode, performs auto page turningPagewith a specified period: 5, 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60seconds, or Never.
- *Volume* Press  $\blacktriangleleft$ ,  $\succ$  to adjust the volume.
- *Start Up* Set the desired start up picture (8 pictures available).

Screen

- Shut DownSet the desired shut down picture (8 picturesScreenavailable).
- Dictionaries Select the desired dictionary for use in books: English Dictionary, Eng-Rus Dictionary, Eng-Pol Dictionary, Rus-Eng Dictionary, Pol-Eng Dictionary.
- *Fonts* Select the desired font for displaying books: *Arial* or *Verdana*.

### System Settings

Serial Number	Show the device serial number.
Battery	Check battery status.
Memory Capacity	Check free memory available in your device.
Card Capacity	Check free memory available on the SD card.
Firmware Version	Show the ECTACO® jetBook® firmware version.
Restore Defaults	Discard custom settings. Press OK to confirm.
Upgrade Patch	Update the ECTACO <sup>®</sup> jetBook <sup>®</sup> firmware, if available.

#### Internal File Manager

Using this function, you can manage books, pictures, music and other files stored in the internal memory of the device (112MB capacity). There are two submenus available in the *Internal File Manager: Files* and *Format*.

Files Select the Books folder, Music folder, or Pictures folder and then press OK. You will see the Files menu which has the following options: Open, Copy, Delete, and Rename. Select the desired option and then press OK.
Format Delete all data stored in the internal memory of the device.

### SD Card File Manager

Using this function, you can manage books, pictures, music and other files stored on the SD card. There are two submenus available in the *SD Card File Manager*: *Files* and *Format*.

*Files* Browse the SD card. The available operations are the same as those used in the *Internal File Manager*.

*Format* Delete all data stored on the SD card.

## **Background Music**

Use this option to control background music. You will see the *Background Music* menu with the following options: *Start* or *Stop*, *Forward*, *Backward*, *Volume*.

Start or Stop If the Start option is chosen, the device will start playing MP3 files, if any. If the Stop option is chosen, playback will stop.

Backward Play the previous MP3 file.

*Forward* Play the next MP3 file.

*Volume* Adjust the volume. Press  $\blacktriangleleft$ ,  $\succ$  to adjust the volume. Press *OK* to confirm your choice.
